

# Year 4 Autumn

## Reading

We will be reading The Queen's Nose, The Boy at the Back of The Class and a range of short texts to develop our retrieval and inference skills.

# Maths



In maths, we will be building on our knowledge of place value, written methods for all operations  $(+,-, x, \div)$ , fractions and decimals as well as learning our times tables up to 12.

# Writing

We will be using the story of 'Beowulf' to write a setting description, a nonchronological report and a character description.

## Science

We will be looking at sound and how it travels. After half term, we will be looking at materials and states of matter. We will investigate which materials change state and how temperature affects this.

#### **Geography and History**

We have a history focus this term, which is Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, and their impact on British history.

#### Art & DT

In Art, we will be looking at drawing and print making. In DT, we will investigate structures and make a Christmas stocking.

#### PSHE and Religion & Worldviews:

Our PSHE units are 'Being Me In My World' and 'Celebrating Difference'. Our RW units are 'Judaism' and 'Christianity at Christmas'.

#### Computing

We will be understanding digital footprints and online theft along with developing skills with presentation software.



#### <u>Music</u>

In Year 4, children will be receiving music tuition from Suffolk County Music Service where they will learn percussion, applying concepts of pitch, tempo, rhythm and dynamics.

#### <u>PE</u>

We will use netball and football to develop our skills in invasion games along with working on our gymnastic and dance skill<u>s</u>.
