As a School, we will provide regular information regarding attendance. Parents and carers can access their child's attendance through the Arbor App. Term dates are shared through our school website, curriculum booklets and monthly newsletters. Each week we celebrate the attendance of the top three classes as well as celebrating individual attendance in termly Rewards Assemblies. Senior leaders meet and greet the children onto the premises daily, they are supported by a team of dedicated morning staff who check in with individuals who need support transitioning into school each day.
