Reading



We will be reading:

- Leon and the place between

We will be focusing on retrieval skills and reading with fluency.

Writing



We will be writing recounts; instructions to make a paper plane; and a setting description. We will continue with focusing on the accuracy of our spellings and handwriting.

Maths



We will focus on place value, addition and subtraction using column method with up to 3 digit numbers, multiplication, division as well as learning to tell the time to the nearest minute.

Science



We will focus on forces and magnets investigating friction and how magnets work. After half term, we will be observing rocks and conducting tests to understand the properties of them.

Geography



We will be learning about the geography of the world and have a particular focus on North America.



Computing

Our computing units are 'Online Safety' and 'Simulations'.



Art & DT



In Art, we will be painting and print-making. In D&T, we will explore structures and textiles.

Music



We will consider song structure and sing with expression in 2-part harmony.
