



# Year 4 SPRING

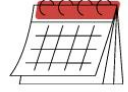


The Year 4 team are Mrs Watson, Miss Binge, Mr Willey, Mrs Osborne and Mr O-Sullivan.

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## Reading



We will be reading *Young, Gifted and Black*, *Charlotte's Web* and *Little People Big Dreams- Michael Jordan* to develop our retrieval and inference skills.



## Writing



We will be writing parts of a story, a play script for a news broadcast, a setting description of Tutankhamun's tomb and a non-chronological report on Egyptian Gods.



## Maths



We will continue to develop our knowledge of place value, written methods for all operations (+, -, x, ÷), fractions and decimals.



## Science

We will be looking at animals, including humans, to investigate the digestive system, senses and learning more about teeth. We will then move onto looking at food chains.



## Geography and History

We have a history focus this term, which is Egyptians and their impact on world history.



## Computing

We will be introducing the children to coding using a range of computing devices to create animations.



## Art & DT

In art, we will be creating a collage and developing our painting skills further. In DT, we are cooking pizza and making a pop-up Egyptian toy.



## Music
