Reading



We are reading 'And Tango makes Three', 'The Lion Inside', 'The Hare and the Tortoise' and 'The Proudest Blue: A story of Hijab and Family'.





In literacy, we will be writing instructions about how to plant a seed, writing our own story of Handa's surprise, writing a postcard describing Kenya and comparing animals using 'er' and 'est'.





In maths, we will be learning how to multiply by making groups and will be comparing and measuring weights. Also, we will be learning about number bonds to 20 and how we can use this knowledge for addition and subtraction facts.



Science

We will be learning about parts of a plant and tree. We will also be learning to name common trees and plants, planting our own bulbs and sorting trees into evergreen and deciduous.



History/Geography

In Geography, we will be comparing England and Kenya. We will be looking at maps and locating them on maps.



We will be learning to understand the functionality of the basic direction keys, to create and debug a set of instructions (algorithm) and use code to make a computer program.



In art, we will use recycled materials to create a sculpture and learn about using collage techniques. In DT, we will be working our how can build a house out of bread.



Music

We will develop our body percussion techniques to invent and perform rhythms over steady beats.



PSHE and RW

We will discuss what makes a good relationship and changes that occur over time. In RW we will be learning about Christianity and Hinduism.

PE

We will be focusing on Athletics and gymnastics.
