Reading



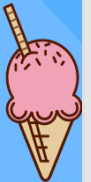
We will be reading 'Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World', 'Fantastic Mr. Fox', and some of Aesop's fables.

Maths

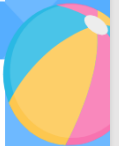


We are recapping addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at statistics, measurements, position and direction.



Science

This half-term, we will grow our own pea sprouts to support us with learning about plants. In Summer 2, we will be studying animals including humans.



History/Geography

We will be finding out about 'The Great Fire of London' this term.



Computing

We will be creating spreadsheets and looking at photography.



Art

We will be creating our own sculptures and developing our drawing techniques.



Music

In Music, we will create chants and rhythm phrases to musically reflect different states of 'Weather'. We'll then learn how to write, read and perform these using simple ideas of scoring for music. We will also extend our musical appraisal skills by listening in detail to pieces of orchestral music.
