Subject	Activity	Resources to help
Maths	<p>Get someone to write you a random 10 Maths questions - time yourself, how quickly can you get them all right?</p> <p>You could make this into a competition and get someone else in your house to try too!</p>	
English	<p>Watch the Road's End video again and think about how the characters are feeling at various points in the video. Consider what their emotion is and how you know by the way they look or the way they are acting.</p> <p>Look at the screenshots taken from the video and have a go at writing some character descriptions using show, not tell - aim for a minimum of five, written within sentences. Use my example to help you.</p> <p>If you fancy the challenge, you can write more or embed them within a longer piece of writing -perhaps a short diary entry.</p>	<p>https://www.literacyshed.com/roads-end.html</p> <p>Screenshots of video Example</p>
Reading	<p>Read your reading book for 20 minutes - this could be something you have been enjoying at home or your reading book from school. Make a comfortable reading area - this could be as elaborate as a den or your bedroom!</p>	
Spellings	<p>Have a look at this week's spelling words and then get someone to test you - let your teacher know how you get on!</p>	
Art	<p>Draw the view from a window in your home again - this could be the same window or a different one. Think about how the scene might have changed by changing the perspective or how doing it on a different week/ time has changed the scene. Can you see evidence of the changing seasons?</p>
