Maths

1. When I plant seeds, for every 3 daffodil seeds I plant 2 rose bushes. If I plant 14 rose bushes, how many daffodil seeds have I planted? **21 daffodils**

2. Every time I eat celebrations, for every Bounty I force myself to eat, I eat 6 Galaxy Caramels. If I eat 9 Bounty chocolates, how many galaxy caramels have I eaten? **54 Galaxy Caramels**

3. At the local farm, each chicken lays 4 eggs. How many eggs if there are 7 chickens? **28 eggs**

4. In a box of chocolates, there are 24 white chocolates, 16 milk chocolates and 8 dark chocolates. Write the ratio of white to dark to milk chocolate. Can you use your fraction knowledge to write this in its simplest form? (Remember, if you divide one, you need to divide them all by the same amount.) **24: 16: 8 OR 3:2:1**

5. Olaf catches snowflakes to a ratio of 2:3 - for every 2 he catches, he misses 3. In one month, Olaf catches 42 snowflakes. How many does he miss? **63 snowflakes**

6. Dory is very forgetful. The ratio of things remembered to not remembered is 1:4. If Dory remembers 6 things, how many things has she not remembered? **24 things not remembered**
