They will all be about area and perimeter, but a mix of squares, rectangles, triangles and parallelograms. | Reading | Have a go at the <u>inference questions</u> related to Inkheart. Remember, you need to follow the <u>PEE structure</u> : a point to answer the question, evidence from the text which links to that point, and an explanation of the link. | Inkheart inference questions |
