How does Mo feel about reading books aloud? (3 marks)

- He likes reading books aloud
- "Mo had helped her with the reading, of course"

0 marks - the evidence is incorrectly copied from the text and does no evidence in the text supports the point.

How does Mo feel about reading books aloud? (3 marks)

- He does not like reading books aloud
- "He had never read aloud to her. Never once, not a single word, however often she put books in his lap."

2 marks - a good point, supported by evidence. However, there is no explanation.

How does Mo feel about reading books aloud? (3 marks)

- He hates reading books aloud
- ""He had never read aloud to her. Never once, not a single word, however often she put books in his lap."
- The fact that Meggie has often given him books and he refused to read all of them indicates that he really hates to read aloud. If you hate doing something, you will refuse to do it.

3 marks - a good point, supported by evidence from the text and with a clear explanation.
