Maths	This week you are going to be looking at word problems - have a look at these basic one step word problems and have a go. Remember you can underline or highlight anything in the questions.	Questions Answer sheet
English	Follow the link to watch the Road's End video. Watch the video a second time and think about what is actually happening - what can you see? Make some notes or discuss what you can retrieve from the video - this may be related to the characters and setting. Watch the video again and decide what you think is happening - what is the story being told here? Reading	We are going to be looking at different texts and their film adaptations this week. Today's focus is Winnie the Pooh. Watch the clip and then write two lists: what can you retrieve as fact from the clip; what can you infer (work out) from the clip. Spellings	Have a look at this week's spelling words and practise these in whichever way works best for you. You could try writing them out as much as you can, a spelling scribble, a spelling pyramid or make a spelling game.
