Roald Dahl was born in Wales in 1916. Both of his parents were from Norway.

He did not like following rules and got in trouble a lot at school. Once, he got told off by his teacher for putting a mouse into a jar.

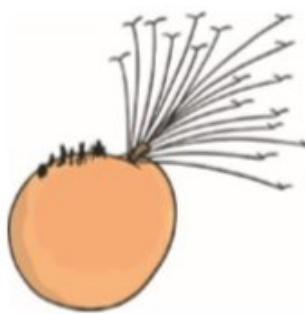
After finishing school, he went travelling to many different places, including Canada and Africa. He flew planes in the Second World War but was badly injured in a crash in Egypt.

After the war, Roald Dahl moved to America and started writing. Before writing books for children, he wrote stories for newspapers.



Did you know?  
Roald Dahl helped to write the film 'Chitty Chitty Bang Bang'.

Roald Dahl loved reading his children bedtime stories. These stories gave him ideas that he would use for his children's books.



His first book for children was *James and the Giant Peach*. It was published in 1961. He went on to write 19 children's books in total. Since then, many of these books have been made into films.

Roald Dahl sadly died in 1990, when he was 74 years old.

**1. Fold the upper left corner to the lower right corner, then unfold.**



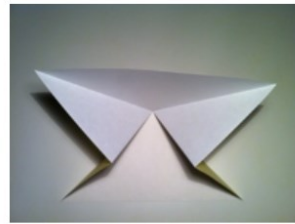
**2. Fold the upper right corner to the lower left corner, then unfold.**

**7. Fold the top flap over the bottom one as shown.**
