Subject	Activity	Resources to help
Maths	Today you will continue to explore rectilinear shapes by finding their areas. Remember, the area is the inside of the shape and we always show the measurement as squared (e.g. 6cm ²). English	Look at the pictures attached - they have been taken from Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone and show the letter that Harry received. I have included a recreated version of this letter too, which was used for filming. <u>Watch the clip</u> to see the film version of build up towards Harry receiving the letter. What is the purpose of the letter? <u>Make notes or annotate the letter to show the features that make it a letter.</u> Harry was unaware of the witchcraft and wizardry in his family history. Think about how he would have felt upon receiving this letter and what sort of response he may want to give.
