<b>Maths</b>	<p>This week you are going to be looking at word problems - look at the pictures and write a one step word problem for each one. Just like yesterday's ones!</p> <p>Once you've done that make sure you work out the answers to them too so you have a mark scheme. Maybe someone in your house could give them a go for you to mark!</p>	Pictures
<b>English</b>	<p>Revisit the Road's End video from yesterday. Today think about the characters in the video. Look at the images attached of the two characters: the driver and the man in the red scarf. <b>Reading</b>	<p>Read the extract from Winnie the Pooh and have a go at the retrieval and vocabulary questions.</p>	Extract Questions
<b>Spellings</b>	<p>Have a look at this week's spelling words and practise these in whichever way works best for you.</p> <p>You could try writing them out as much as you can, a spelling scribble, a spelling pyramid or make a spelling game.</p>	
<b>Topic</b>	<p>Look at the 4 world maps attached. Make notes on what the same is and what is different between them. What can we learn from each map? Why different styles of maps may be created - how are they useful?</p>	World maps
