Watching and Waiting...



Here's an example of what you could have **thought** and **written**...

expanded noun phrase

The **beautiful, young** woman waited for the **delayed** plane to arrive. She sat

preposition

by the clock, counting down the minutes. She would miss her connecting

conjunction 'if'

prefix -mis

flight **if** the plane did not arrive soon. Unless she was **mistaken**, the plane

exclamation sentence

should have arrived fifteen minutes ago. **What** a tense moment it was!
